#### Budgeting 101: Why is it important to have budget?


- It helps you better manage your money




#### What is OSAP?

Bursaries are **non-repayable awards** given primarily on the basis of financial need.

Disabilities

If eligible, up to \$22,000 for disability-related educational costs (equipment/services) Demonstrate \$1 financial need (through OSAP application)

Ask the Financial Aid & Awards Office or the Student Wellness Department for more information

Provides aid to students self-identifying as having a permanent, prolonged, or persistent disability

## Scholarships

**Entrance Scholarships are** determined based on high school average and portfolio information. No application is required.

From years 1-3, In-study Scholarships are available, and are <u>automatically</u> considered based on academic merit.

Scholarships are awarded as a tuition credit.

# Awards

#### **Fourth-Year Awards & Medals**

Awards recognize achievement in each Program major at the fourth-year level normally through a juried competition at the end of each academic year.

Awards can be based on a combination of criteria.
