Your portfolio is an important part of your application and should be a visual representation of who you are.

Most portfolios* require the following:

8 TO 10 ART/DESIGN PIECES

• Show us a variety of works, as well as some that relate to your program.

• Include a brief description of each work.

SKETCHBOOK/PROCESS WORK

• Let us see your process, research, development, experiments & inspiration.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 250 to 300 words
- Explain your interest in the program and tell us about you and your work.

*Portfolio requirements may differ for each program. Instead of a portfolio, Visual and Critical Studies (BA) requires a writing sample submission. *Details will emailed once you submit your application.*

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

HIGH SCHOOL: An overall average of 70% in your final year of high school including senior level academic English with 70% or higher.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB): 3 HL + 3 SL with a minimum of 24 points and English with at least a 4. HL courses with a 5 or higher may be eligible for transfer credit.

BRITISH PATTERN CURRICULUM: GCSE/IGCSE with 5 O-Levels with C or better as well as GCE with 2 A-Levels or 4 AS-Levels. English required at the O-Level.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) COURSES:

Transfer credits may be awarded for students acheiving a grade of at least 5 in Higher Level IB courses approved as equivalent to OCAD U courses.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSES:

Transfer credits may be awarded for students acheiving a grade of 4 or higher in AP courses approved as equivalent to OCAD U courses.

*Additional proof of English Language Proficiency may be required. <u>Always check online for the most up-to-date entrance requirements.</u>
